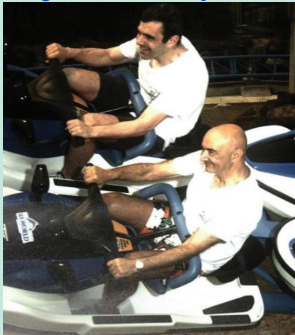

Focus on Dento – Alveolar Trauma *Monday 23 March*

“Dento-alveolar trauma management of the secondary dentition - Quick decisions with long term consequences”



Trauma usually happens at the most inopportune time. Patients and their families often present in distress. Is dento-alveolar trauma management always an emergency? Is time always critical during management of dento-alveolar trauma? How do we assess pulpal changes following trauma? When is it necessary to undertake RCT? When/how long is splinting required? These questions will be answered with a series of case reports that will highlight a practical approach to the management of dento-alveolar trauma.

“Primary tooth trauma – a review of the immediate and long term management and a discussion of the consequences to the primary and secondary dentition following primary tooth trauma.”



Primary tooth trauma is very common in young children. The immediate management can be challenging when caring for a pre-co-operative child and managing parental expectations in a time of high stress and emotions. After the immediate care, what can we expect to occur to the primary dentition and developing permanent dentition? This lecture aims to review the immediate management of primary tooth trauma and discuss the long-term consequences and further dental care the child may experience.

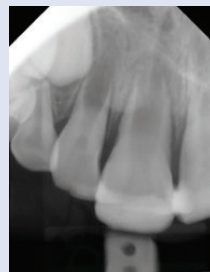

THE PRACTICAL CORNER - FOCUS ON DENTO-ALVEOLAR TRAUMA

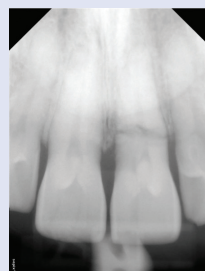
Case Consideration:

Management of these and other cases will be discussed at this seminar:

1. When a patient presents looking like this what runs through your mind when managing this case? The patient knocked and laterally luxated tooth 11 three weeks ago and now swelling has commenced around tooth 11



2. Patient knocked tooth 11 yesterday. The tooth is slightly mobile. Your radiograph shows a horizontal root fracture at the gingival margin level



3. A patient presented with a history of intrusion of teeth 52, 51, 61 and 62. By the time the patient presented some 18 months later the intruded teeth had been extracted. How old is the patient now? Why were teeth 52, 51, 61 and 62 extracted? Does position of intrusion determine the decision? Why not just leave the intruded primary teeth? What advice do I give to the guardian of what to expect from the secondary dentition? What possible factors can make the management of this patient more complicated?
